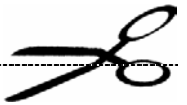
The authority you give to charge your account will remain in effect until you notify us or your bank in writing to terminate the authorization.

Authorization for Automatic Payments

I authorize Owatonna Public Utilities and the bank named below to initiate variable entries to my checking account. This authority will remain in effect until I notify you or the bank in writing to cancel it in such time as to afford the bank a reasonable opportunity to act on it. I can stop payment of any entry by notifying you or the bank 7 business days before my account is charged. I can have the amount of an erroneous charge immediately credited to my account up to 15 days following issuance of my bank statement or 46 days after posting, whichever occurs first.
